TOWARD A RESPONSE-ABILITY OF AESTHETIC DISTANCE: Thoughts on Visual Communication

Relation is the very fabric of communication. It is an atmosphere of sensing and responding, endlessly conferring. Through this, we're able to access a friend, a home, a feeling, our surroundings, ourselves. It is embodied sense-making. For us humans, it is language in its most plural form.

Visual communication, which involves graphic design along with the multitude of visual traditions and forms of mark making, is attentive to how visual forms mediate sense. It looks at how form renders possible/impossible ways of knowing. Navigating this requires us to look closely at the contexts and relations

which frame particular forms. Aesthetics becomes a matter of ethics.

In my practice, I see visual communication as sense-making tools. Its traditions are situated and entangled, so it becomes necessary to confer with other ways of knowing across the already polycultural and multi-disciplined.
